- Quality Counts Stipends:
  - Education Stipend
    - Tier 1 (\$1,200) 6+ units towards a degree in ECE, CD permit upgrade, or to meet job requirements
    - Tier 2 (\$700) 3 units towards a degree in ECE, CD permit upgrade, or to meet job requirements
  - Professional Growth Stipend
    - \$500 for 21 hours of professional growth (including PD hours obtained by taking college units not applicable under the education stipend)
  - 85 Center-Based stipends processed (\$65,600)
    - 6 Education Tier 1 Stipends (\$4,200)
    - 32 Education Tier 2 Stipends (\$38,400)
    - 47 Professional Development Stipends (\$23,500)

#### **SLO COUNTY ARPA PROPOSAL**

- SLO County Board of Supervisors has set aside dedicated funds towards child care. County partners are working together to define how this will be allocated, but initial outlines include:
  - o The San Luis Obispo Office of Education will serve as fiscal lead.
  - The San Luis Obispo County Child Care Planning Council (the County's existing dedicated advisory body on child care need for children 0-12) will provide governance and program oversight, and will serve as program lead on quality improvement as part of its Quality Counts initiative.
  - o Proposed areas of indirect investment into the child care sector:
    - Child care sector program relief & stabilization
    - Program expansion and quality improvement
    - Reinvigoration of the child care workforce
  - Approved by County Board of Supervisors on March 15<sup>th</sup>. Currently we are in final contract stages. We will be ready to start July 1. There will be a subcontract with CAPSLO CCRC to support Provider Outreach and TA.

Motion to add action item to Council agenda for approval; establish a Local Economic Development Sub-Committee to support ARPA grant process and other business development efforts.
