Cherie Fields, San Luis Obispo County Public Health

- Nursing division still has a number of staff reassigned to emergency services (COVID testing, swabbing and contract tracing)
- <u>Public Health Home Visiting Program</u> opened for full service on July 6. Face-to-face visits are being offered with proper personal protective equipment.
- <u>Immunization Clinics</u> open since May 4 by appointment (Paso Robles, San Luis Obispo, & Grover Beach). Immunization rates have decreased. Will help Public Health create a flyer to help spread the word and make sure children are getting their immunizations.
- Family Planning Clinic open in Paso Robles

Katie Mervin, Cuesta College Children's Center

- Fall semester starts August 7, most of the classes will be online.
- Last chance for Practicum in own workplace setting this semester.
- Cuesta College Children's Center is fully enrolled
- <u>Ticket 2 Teach</u> is going steady

Lauren Thorne, San Luis Obispo County Office of Education

- New Director of Educational Support Services replacing Nancy Norton
- Waiting on Management Bulletin for more direction.
- Challenged with staff that are unable to go back to the classroom due to health conditions.

Mika Buchanan, CAPSLO Child Care Resource Connection - Alternative Payment Program

- Enrolled 159 children over the course of May and June
- Child care was originally going to service through June 30th
- With the passing of 20/21 State budget child care is extended for 90 days or until funding allows
- Eligible families have first priority for enrollment into CAPP, CMAP, CCTR, or CSPP
- Currently: 4% use Lic. Exempt Centers, 16% use Trustline Providers, 28% use Lic. Centers, 51% use Lic. FDC's Child Care
- Child care for all funded programs will be paid based on parent's max certified need for child care

Payment will be made without regard to attendance, meaning if the child is absent or doesn't
use all the child care they are approved CCRC will still pay the child care provider for the parents
maximum certified need for child care
