QUALITY COUNTS UPDATE – Britney Ogden

- Quality Counts Enrollment
 - Total Participants: 95
 - Active Center-Based Programs: 54
 - 10 Private Centers
 - 14 Head Start / Early Head Start / Migrant Seasonal Head Start
 - 9 State-Funded Preschools
 - 3 Higher-Education Child Care Centers
 - 5 School District Operated Programs
 - 13 Alternative Programs (*Special Education, Parent Participation, etc.*)
 - Active Family Child Care: 41
 - Center-Based Enrollment & Recruitment
 - 54 participating center-based sites
 - Family Child Care (FCC) Enrollment & Recruitment
 - 41 actively participating family child care providers
 - 2 newly enrolled
 - Two licensed providers attended a one-on-one orientation this quarter and are fully enrolled in Quality Counts. Providers are actively engaging in activities, and following quality improvement/ commitment plans. Providers learned about Quality Counts through peers, and Resource and Referral Program.
- Quality Counts Stipend Program
 - Current Application:
 - 43 Education Stipend
 - 80 Professional Growth Stipend
 - All applications to be processed beginning May 1st
 - Education Stipend
 - Tier 1 (\$1,200) – 6+ units towards a degree in ECE, CD permit upgrade, or to meet job requirements
 - Tier 2 (\$700) – 3 units towards a degree in ECE, CD permit upgrade, or to meet job requirements
 - Professional Growth Stipend
 - \$500 for 21 hours of professional growth (including PD hours obtained by taking college units not applicable under the education stipend)
